The Construction Trades Academy is a combination of trade specific study and on-the-job training. The program is designed to take someone who may have little or no experience in their chosen field to journey-level in four years. This is accomplished by utilizing hands-on-experience and trade related instruction.

ABC Greater Tennessee offers course training through Mike Holt Enterprises and the National Center for Construction Education and Research (NCCER). Mike Holt has been serving the electrical industry for over 40 years, creating and publishing books, DVDs, online training and curriculum. NCCER develops standardized construction and maintenance curriculum and assessments for the industry.

ACCREDITED QUALITY CONTRACTOR


The Accredited Quality Contractor program was launched in 1993. This program publicly recognizes and honors those construction firms that have documented their commitment in five areas of corporate responsibility:
