The student must be enthusiastic, read, write, comprehend English and able to do math at an 8th grade level, 18 or older, able to legally work in the United States, graduated High School with a proof of diploma or GED, a State of Tennessee proof of identification for first year students, work faithfully and diligently at the occupation, physically able to perform on a construction site as required for the job, pass a drug test, have reliable transportation, and go on job interviews and respond to prospective employers in a timely manner.

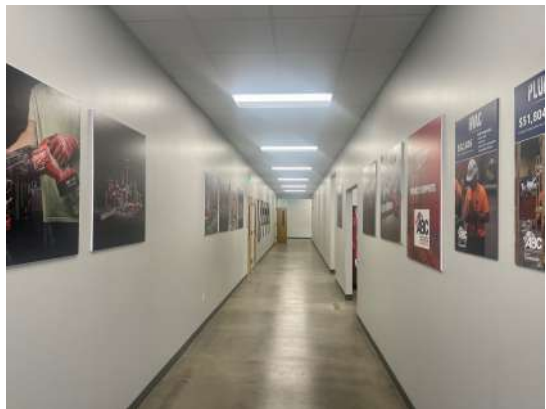
